

MARK TWAIN CHESS CLUB Winter 2014

This year Mark Twain School is teaming up with Chess4Life to offer a fun instructional chess club! Students in grades K through 5 are invited to join the club.

Classes are tailored to the skill-level of the students. In addition to learning the basic rules of chess, our classes include lessons on fundamental opening principles, middlegame tactics and strategy, as well as basic endgame technique. Coaches also work with students in other areas like visualization, preparing for tournament competition, board habits, and much more.

Benefits

Chess study has shown to increase math skills, concentration, memory, and self-confidence.

Tuition

\$142 (for the full 10 week session)

10% discount for siblings (\$128)

Meeting Times: Fridays from 3:00 pm to 4:15pm (1 hour 15 minutes) in the Library. Based on the skill level of the students and the number of registrations, we may split the class into an advanced section and a beginner section. The advanced section will learn tournament preparation drills.

Enrollment: All levels of ability are accepted, beginners to advanced. We need a **minimum of 15 kids** to run the club – if we can't get the minimum, chess club may be cancelled.

Dates: We follow the Lake Washington District calendar - no club during days when there is no Friday afternoon school. **The fall session runs for 10 weeks – January 10, 17, 24, 31, February 7, (no class Feb 14), 21, 28, March 7, (no class March 14), 21, 28**

Tournaments: Tournament participation is optional but encouraged for those who are ready. We will target one tournament per month Nov - Apr in the greater Seattle area to test our skills against other schools. Tournaments usually run on Saturdays from 8:30am to 4:00pm – there are 5 games, each 1 hour long – kids play all 5 games win or lose. The State Championship is at the end of April - players need 3 out of 5 wins in any tournament to qualify for state.

Not included: tournament registration fees (about \$18 per tournament), and T- shirts for tournaments.

2. Write a check for \$142 payable to [Twain PTSA](#). (Checks returned NSF are subject to a \$20 fee.)
3. Deliver registration form and check to the School Office.
4. If the minimum number of students is not reached your money will be returned.
5. Joining after class has started? \$14/session * remaining sessions + a flat \$2.
