Mark Twain PTSA: Introduction to Coding! Wednesdays 4/16-6/11 1:30pm - 2:45pm, Cafeteria

Want to become a coding star and write your own programs? Start by learning programming fundamentals in our introductory class. By the end of this session, you will have created several drawing programs and a computer game you can share with your friends!

In addition to coding, students develop key life skills such as *problem solving, logical thinking, teamwork, and creativity*. Our innovative curriculum allows students to work at their own pace so that beginning students can take the time they need to get a solid understanding, and more advanced students can be challenged with additional projects.

Introduction to Coding - A / Grades 2-3 (max 15 students)

Using drag-and-drop programming environments, students will complete a sequence of increasingly difficult coding challenges. Through practice, kids will learn key programming concepts and create their first computer programs, such as turtle graphics and simple games. Primary programming tool used is Scratch.

Introduction to Coding - B / Grades 4-5 (max 15 students)

This class covers same topics as the "A" class and more. Designed for older students, it starts from the very beginning, but runs in an accelerated format that extends to additional programming concepts and projects. Primary programming tool used is Scratch.

Introduction to Coding costs \$146 for an 8-week session. **No class on 5/28** Make checks payable to "Mark Twain PTSA".
