Redmond High School Dance Guidelines

Entry to a Redmond High School dance will close 90 minutes after the start of the dance.

All students will be asked to show ID at the door.

Redmond High students may bring a guest *only* if they have followed the Guest Pass Procedure and the guest's name is on the guest pass approved list. This must be done by the Tuesday prior to the dance. Guests must also have proper ID.

A student who leaves the dance will not be readmitted. A student who has an emergency and needs to leave the dance for a moment must talk with an administrator to explain the situation.

Students who attend a dance or school function under the influence of drugs/alcohol will be suspended. Parents and law enforcement will be notified.

Only Seniors and dates will be allowed to attend the Senior Prom.

While dancing, students at a Redmond High School dance are expected to behave in a way that is appropriate and will not make anyone uncomfortable. There will be no dancing which mimics or simulates sexual acts. No hands under clothing and all attire must meet the same requirements as clothing worn during the school day.

Administrators and teacher chaperones will enforce guidelines when necessary. If a student does not respond to a warning to stop inappropriate behavior he/she may be asked to leave the dance and parents will be notified.
