Have you heard the terms FBA, BIP, or PBIP and wondered what these terms mean? Have you been told the school wants to do a functional behavior assessment on your child but aren't sure why or what to expect? Are you wondering if your child needs a functional behavior assessment or a positive behavior plan? This class will answer these questions. It will explain what a functional behavior assessment (FBA) is, when a child might need one, and what you should expect from a high quality FBA. It will also cover how an FBA leads to a positive behavior intervention plan (PBIP) and what you should look for or expect in a high quality behavior plan.
