Entering is easy. Here's how:

- 1. Sign up! Complete and return the attached permission slip/information packet request form.
- 2. Choose an art category:



Visual Arts - Includes drawing, painting, printmaking, collage.

Literature - Includes plays, poems, stories, essays, song lyrics



Music - Create an original musical composition, recorded on cassette tape or CD.

Photography – Black and white, color, touched up, digital, double print, altered photos.



Choreography/Dance - Created and perform an original dance, recorded on DVD.

- 3. Have your child choose a project idea that expresses the theme "Diversity Means...". (To see how students have interpreted last year's theme, visit <u>www.wastatepta.org</u>. Click on Programs and then on Reflections.)
- 4. Let your child be creative and have fun! Art pieces should be created at home or at special lunch recess workshops at school, if we can get volunteers! (Reflections is NOT a series of art classes.)
- 5. Have your child <u>create a unique title</u> that connects the entry to the theme. A statement on the entry form explaining how the work interprets the theme is highly recommended.
- 6. Prepare the entry for display and judging according to the guidelines in the information packet.
- 7. Turn in your entry to the RHE school office. The deadline will be in October 26, 2011.
