MANDATORY PARENT MEETING: Tuesday, May 1, 2012, 7:00 p.m. in the Library

This is for parents of registered students. Student actors can also attend. At this meeting, you will meet the directors, discuss the schedule of auditions and rehearsals, review the parent packet and committee work, and answer any of your questions.

AUDITIONS: May 7, 8 & 10, 2012 after school, Music Room Auditions will consist of a oneminute monologue that your child will memorize ahead of time (a selection of monologues will be included in the packet given out at the parent meeting. Your child's specific audition time will be assigned at the parent meeting. All registered students receive a part in the play. Auditions are simply to allow the directors to see the child's personality and comfort level performing so they are better able to cast the parts of the play. Students receive their parts on Friday, May 11. Scripts are handed out and we'll do a read-through and start learning songs.

REHEARSALS: Rehearsals begin Monday, May 14 at 3:15pm in the gym and music room.

Rehearsals will be in the gym and music room from 3:15 to 5:30 p.m., Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays (No Wednesdays). The last week of rehearsals will go as late as 6:00 p.m. at Lake Washington High School. The full rehearsal schedule will be finalized after the play is cast by the directors in two week increments (this flexibility allows us to increase or decrease our focus on certain scenes/songs as necessary).

<u>CONFLICTS</u>: Please check your calendars for any possible conflicts. We need to know these conflicts **prior** to auditions so the directors can schedule your child's rehearsals accordingly. Please remember that cast members will be required to attend all of his/her assigned rehearsals as it takes a great effort to learn lines, stage dances and musical numbers, and to build a sense of teamwork. Not every cast member will be called to every rehearsal during the early weeks, but **all** cast members will be required to attend rehearsals the final week through the performance nights. **No conflicts are permitted June 11 thru 16, 2012.**

REGISTRATION FEE: \$ 100.00/child

The registration fee <u>must</u> accompany the audition/registration form. The fee is non-refundable unless your child decides not to participate prior to auditions. A few partial scholarships are available. If you would like to apply for one, please contact Arlene Kettering for the scholarship form at least a week prior to the application due date. Completed scholarship applications are to be attached to regular application forms.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES: Parent involvement is required.

In order to produce a quality show, we need parents to be involved. There are opportunities to volunteer during the day, the evening, at home, or at school. Volunteer sign-up forms will be available at the parent meeting.

PERFORMANCES AT LAKE WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL

Parent volunteers will transport the actors from the elementary school to the high school (just a few blocks away) for the last week of rehearsals so that the actors can acclimate themselves to the stage. Permission slips and driver forms will be available at the parent meeting.
