Students in the third through fifth grades will discover the joy of writing through a series of interactive workshops. Beginning with poetry and iambic pentameter (think "Roses are red..."), students will learn that poetry doesn't have to rhyme as we explore Haiku and freestyles; but then explore the relationship between poetry and songs. Fundamentals of short story writing (plot, setting, characters...) follow as we end with learning the relationship between short stories and scripts for plays and movies.
