Math Club is facilitated by Twain teachers who follow the Explorations in Math program to show students how math is relevant to their lives. The goal is to make math fun! This fall, all grade levels will explore measurement.

Discovering Measurement (Grades 1-2): Students will be participating in a variety of activities to explore length in customary and nonstandard units, as well as work with the concepts of perimeter, area, and volume. Participants will explore perimeter and area of standard and irregular polygonal shapes, and also learn about the circumference and diameter of circles and understand the concept of "pi." Ms. Shank is the instructor.

Exploring Measurement (Grades 3-5): Club participants will explore perimeter and area of standard and irregular polygonal shapes, learn about the circumference and diameter of circles, and understand the concept of "pi." Students will have frog jumping contests, windup toy races, and will create fractional representations of each other. These engaging activities will underscore the importance of accurate and verifiable measurement. Instructor TBD.
