Supporting Emotional Needs of the Gifted (SENG) Model-based:

Parents of "highly capable" children are invited to participate in an eight-week series to discuss the social and emotional needs of their children in secondary years. Emphasis is on problem solving, emotional intelligence, avoiding power struggles, and helping gifted children learn appropriate life skills while enhancing the parent/child relationship. These classes will help to improve your understanding of what makes your children both similar and different from their peers.

TOPICS include:

- Understanding motivation and achievement; dealing with perfectionism
- Approaches to discipline and the establishment of appropriate boundaries
- Stress management and identification of the early signs of depression
- Improving peer/sibling/parent relationships and communication of feelings
