We will draw and paint the Red Square, Golden Temple of India, Great Wall of China and the Blue Mosque of Istanbul. In sulpture we will make Easter Island Moai and more as time will allow.

We will integrate one point perspective and disappearing points. We will capture reflections, sky and clouds, water, sunset, shades, and light. We will use pencils, charcoals, soft pastels, oil pastels, watercolor, acrylic on canvas, and 3D sculpture from clay.
