In this session we will discover the rain forest, layer by layer. We will start with the forest floor, then move to the understory, the canopy and finally the emergent layer. We will focus on the rich flora and fauna of the rainforest including toucan and parakeet birds, Heliconia flowers, Boyd’s Forest Dragon (a lizard), frogs and various insects and the people of the rain forest.

We will combine techniques of space composition light and shadow, one-point perspective, two-point perspective and creating depth and 3D. We will use pencils, charcoals, soft pastels, oil pastels, watercolor, acrylic, clay, and foil.
