

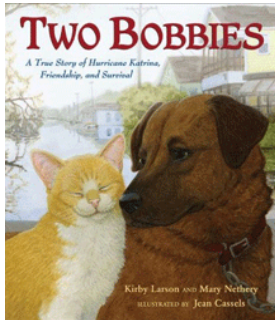

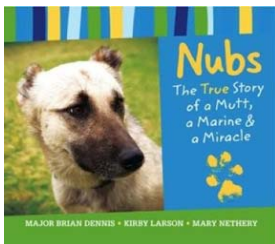
**Two Bobbies** (hard cover)

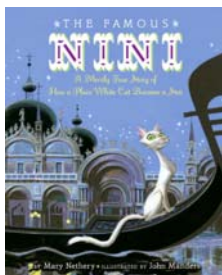

**The Famous Nini: A Mostly True Story of How a Plain White Cat Became a Star** (hard cover) **\*\*NEW\*\***

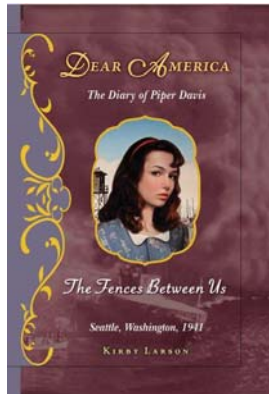
Mary Nethery | Ages 4-8
