This year's exciting show is open to 4th, 5th, and 6th grade students. Studio East will provide directors, scripts, music, sets and costumes. Rose Hill Elementary will provide the kids and parent volunteers. The funds paid to Studio East for this production are raised through the registration fee, ticket sales, program advertising, show concessions, and individual donations.

We are limited to 40 students. **This year, if applicants exceed 40 students, there will be a lottery** with preference given to 6th graders. To participate, fill out and submit to Cindy in the Front Office:

MANDATORY PARENT MEETING: Tuesday, November 2, 2010, 7:00 p.m. in the Library
This is for parents of registered students. At this meeting, we will meet the directors, discuss the schedule of auditions and rehearsals, review the parent packet and committee work, and answer any of your questions.

AUDITIONS: November 8, 9 & 12, 2010 after school, Music Room Auditions will consist of a one-minute monologue that your child will memorize ahead of time (a selection of monologues

will be included in the packet given out at the parent meeting) and a song (feel free to bring your own music. If you don't have a special song to sing, the directors will play a common song your child will know). Your child's specific audition time will be assigned at the parent meeting.

Please remember, all forty registered applicants receive a part in the play. Auditions are simply to allow the directors to see the child's personality and comfort level performing so they are better able to cast the parts of the play.

REHEARSALS: Rehearsals begin Monday, November 15 immediately after school

November 15, roles are announced and the script is read-through. Rehearsals will be in the gym and music room from 3:15 to 5:30 p.m., Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays (No Wednesdays). The last week of rehearsals could go as late as 6:00 p.m. at Rose Hill Junior High. The full rehearsal schedule will be finalized after the play is cast by the directors.

CONFLICTS: Please check your calendars for any possible conflicts. We need to know these conflicts prior to parts being assigned so the directors can schedule your child's rehearsals accordingly. Please remember that cast members will be required to attend all of his/her assigned rehearsals as it takes a great effort to learn lines, stage dances and musical numbers, and to build a sense of teamwork. Not every cast member will be called to every rehearsal during the early weeks, but **all** cast members will be required to attend **all** rehearsals the final week through the performance nights. **No absences are allowed for any reason January 3 thru 7, 2011.**

REGISTRATION FEE: \$ 95.00/child

The registration fee must accompany the audition/registration form. The fee is non-refundable unless your child decides not to participate prior to auditions. If you have concerns about the registration fee, please feel free to call Arlene Kettering at 425-827-2892 *before* the registration due date.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES: Parent involvement is required.

In order to produce a quality show, we need all parents to be involved. Please indicate your preference for volunteer opportunities on the parent volunteer form. We especially need two to three volunteers to help with costumes during daytime (not evening) hours.

PERFORMANCES AT RHJH

Because of the construction going on at Lake Washington High School, performances will be held in the auditorium at Rose Hill Junior High. We will transport the children from the elementary school to the junior high (just a few blocks away) the last week of rehearsals so that the actors can acclimate themselves to the stage. Permission slips for this will be available at the parent meeting.
