In this fall session, we will cover the Impressionist Period. **Impressionism** was a 19th-century art movement that began as a loose association of Paris-based artists exhibiting their art publicly in the 1860s. We will cover the artists Degas, Renoir, Monet, Cezanne, Gauguin, van Gogh and Mary Cassatt (the lone American).

We will combine techniques of space composition light and shadow, one-point perspective, two-point perspective and creating depth and 3D. We will use pencils, charcoals, soft pastels, oil pastels, watercolor, acrylic, clay, and foil.
